I developed branding & advertising for "Digital Maker CIC" - A company I am involved with, delivering computing, design & creative thinking to people aged 9+.



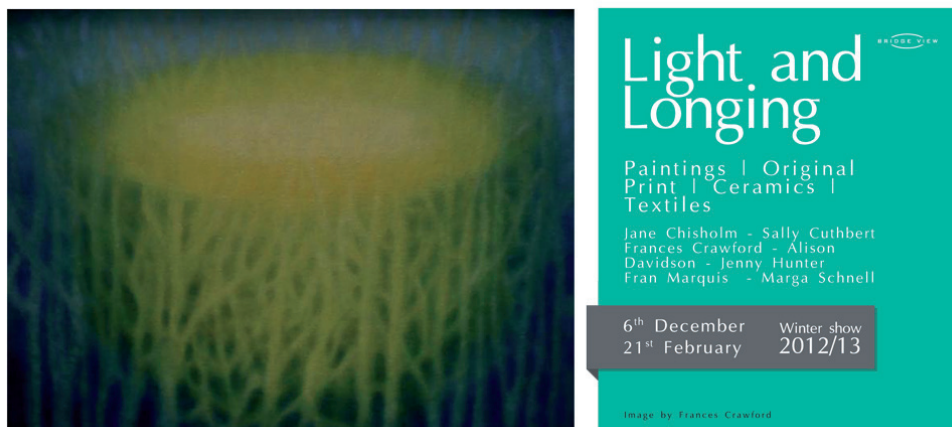
CENTRICA
